## EDUCATION & EMPLOYMENT

Information about adult education opportunities, financial aid resources, resume development, employment services and skills training services, as well as on-site job applications for local businesses.

## FOOD & NUTRITION

Nutrition information and education programs, local food and food pantry resources, help with applying for the Food Assistance Program (SNAP), as well as snack bags to take home.

## HEALTH & WELLNESS

Blood pressure checks, blood sugar checks, oxygen saturation readouts, oral screenings, vision screenings, and diabetic foot care. Vaccination record review. Resources for cancer awareness and prevention, suicide prevention, pregnancy prevention, PrEP, substance use disorder, office based opioid treatment. Medicare, Medicaid and Affordable Care Act info. Hands only CPR training.

## HOUSING & FINANCE

Help applying for housing, including public housing and Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) program. Heat & energy assistance, info on loans and grants for home repair. Counseling and workshop resources focusing on home ownership, credit education, budget building and foreclosure services.

## KIDS & PARENTING

Info on pregnancy, parenting education, early child development, tuition-free preschool, youth mentoring and teen programming, career and technical education programs, Career Academy for Kids. Resources for families of children with disabilities, summer day camp, local library services, Dolly Parton Imagination Library registration, EZ Child ID CDs, free books and child care items as well as alcohol, drug and nicotine test kits for teens.

## SOCIAL SERVICES

Info on legal options and court forms for simple civil matters. Mediation advice on parenting time, divorce, IEP for kids. Info for senior services including meals for seniors, grief support, Hospice Assist. Training on adaptive equipment for those who are blind or have low vision, resources for captioned phones for hearing impaired. Support for abuse survivors. Info on transportation. Assistance programs focused on members of the LTBB of Odawa Indians.
